Welcome to the Airedale Field Nationals

The Airedale came to America shortly after its development in England in the last half of the 19th century. In the first part of the 20th century, Americans' appreciation of the Airedale's hunting heritage was summarized in 1916 by Warren H. Miller (longtime editor of Field and Stream) in his classic book *The American Hunting Dog.* "On the borderline between the bird dog and the fur dog stands the Airedale," Miller wrote, "...the dog that can hunt both ... and the one who can and is being successfully trained to hunt everything alive that can be hunted."

The Airedale enjoyed widespread popularity in America at the start of the 20th century. In addition to its hunting abilities, the breed's reputation built on its fame as a war dog in WWI and its exploits as a big game hunter in the American West. Over time, demographics and society changed, and Airedale popularity shifted to a much smaller fan base who maintained the breed mainly as companions and home protectors.

Over the past 25 years, there's been a movement among Airedale fanciers to restore attention to the breed's original purpose as a versatile hunting and working dog, and to prove that the Airedale still maintains the breed's original instincts and abilities. Airedale Terriers may now compete in AKC Spaniel Hunt Tests and UKC-based Hunting Retriever Club [HRC] Hunt Tests, as well as Airedale-only hunt tests. Your participation in these Airedale field events shows us your understanding that Airedale inclinations go way beyond the couch and backyard. Thank you for being here!

Tests, Schedule and Entry Fees

Each hunt test will be offered at Junior, Senior, and Master levels. Flushing and Retriever entry fees at all levels are \$65.00 per test. Fur entry fees are \$30 at all levels.

Courses and Birds

Fur trails will be laid using a drag and Cronks Raccoon Scent. Chukar will be used for upland work. Ducks or chukar will be used for water work.

Prizes

Rosettes and certificates will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score at a previously unearned level.

Refunds, Scratches, No Shows

Bitches in season shall not be permitted on the grounds. Entry fees paid for a bitch withdrawn because of coming into season or for a dog withdrawn because of an injury or illness, or for a dog which dies, shall be refunded in full by the test-giving club. Prior to paying such refund, the club may require an appropriate veterinary certificate. Requests and documentation must be presented prior to the test. There will be no refunds for "no shows". Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is disqualified, excused by a judge or barred from the test by action of the test-giving club. No entry fee will be refunded if the test cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, act of God, public emergency, or any other cause beyond the control of the test-giving club.

Upland Judges

Brent LeMaster

Brent is a professional gundog trainer from Amanda, Ohio. He and his wife, Rosalinda, carry on the legacy of Guadaira Kennels, which was started in 1971 by Rosalinda's father, John Issacs (See www.guadairakennels.com). Brent now breeds English Springer Spaniels, but he has owned and trained setters, pointers and cockers. Brent is also the first professional handler to make the first two Master Hunters Advanced in the country, with both a Clumber Spaniel and an European imported Springer Spaniel. In recent years, Brent has done well with his Airedale clients too! He is an AKC Field Trial judge who brings considerable expertise to our HWA test program and our workshop for pups and new dogs.

John Dudash

I live northeast of Gahanna, Ohio with my two English Springer Spaniels, Shiny and Rainy; my Brittany, Windy; and my wife. I have been an avid hunter and fisherman since my teens, in other words a long time. I got my first Springer, Shiny, about 5 years ago and started training with Brent LeMaster and the Ohio Valley English Springer Club about the same time. Shiny and I finished our senior title and master title within a year, having skipped the junior title. The jump from senior to master was not easy and we did not get a leg from the first master events, and it took two events to get that last leg. Shiny and I are now working on Master Advanced; we have two legs towards that title. I have started with my second Springer, Rainy, training for field trials and hope to enter her in puppy stakes this fall. Although I am relatively new I have learned what it takes to be successful, when to reward success, and when to encourage and praise effort. Retriever Judges

Leslie Phillips

I have always been interested in nature and the out-of-doors. Following my B.S., M.S. in Natural Resources from O.S.U., I spent 34 years with Columbus Metro Parks as a Naturalist, Ranger, and Assistant Park Manager.

In 1992 I got my first Flat-Coated Retriever and really started a hobby with dog competition such as obedience, agility, show, and hunt testing. I am now starting on my 6th Flat-Coated Retriever, and while I am not as active with the other venues, I still love the training, competition, and social interaction involved in hunt testing. Becoming an A.K.C. Hunt Test Judge helped so much in my dog training. I still hunt over my dogs as well.

Ed Zawodny

I started hunting with my father a long time ago when I was 10 years old. We had dogs nearly all of my life, but I only discovered hunting with retrievers about 20 years ago when a friend, with a well trained retriever, invited me to go duck hunting. That day got me hooked on retrievers. Competing and hunting with retrievers has since become a passion.

In 2001, my wife and I got our first Flat-Coated Retriever, and the rest is history. We currently have 2 Flat-Coats that I upland and waterfowl hunt with. But, we also compete in Conformation, Obedience and Field with these same dogs. Both dogs have titles in all three areas, all owner trained and handled.

I started judging retriever events about 10-years ago. I am currently:

AKC licensed hunt test judge for all levels (Junior, Senior and Master), UKC licensed hunt test judge for the Started level and soon to be at the Seasoned level and approved to judge breed field events (WC, WCI, WCX) for Flat-Coats, Goldens, Labs, Nova Scotia Duck Tollers.

Hunting Instinct Test Judges

Ed Weiss

In my non-dog life, I am a practicing cardiologist and senior member of a 15-man group. My dog life began with a Rat Terrier named Trixi who ignited my love of the terrier personality, which did not abate until I got my first Airedale in 2001, Ohuivo Brisco. Brisco led me on a merry chase through hunting and VPG (obedience, tracking and protection) training and trialing. He is a do it all dog of inestimable courage, tolerance and patience with me. Brisco has achieved VPG3 (a title reserved for the best of German Shepherds and Malinois). He earned the very difficult FH1 tracking title (1/2 mile in length, including over asphalt that is 2 hrs. old with two cross tracks and six right angle turns). Yes, Airedales have great noses and are capable of complex training! In HWA Brisco achieved a Master Retriever, Senior Upland, and Junior Fur. He is a lot better at fur than his junior title would indicate, to which a covote barn raider would testify, though this would require a spiritualist. Now retired, Brisco is happy to be a pickup dog at the HWA nationals. I am now training and enjoying the company of a young Airedale that answers to the name Kasbah.

Before Airedales and after Trixi, I had a Boxer, Simba, and then a succession of Giant Schnauzers, which I trained and trialed to national level, co-founded the Working Schnauzer Federation in 1991, co-authored a book on dog training published by Denlinger (*Protection Dogs for You and Your Family*) and was a contributing editor to *Dog Sports* magazine. Since thirteen, I have been an avid upland and water fowl hunter. Presently, I belong to the Gateway Retriever Club, St Louis Regional Sporting Spaniel Club, and Spirit of St. Louis Working Dog Club. I am also a member of the ATCA and Board member of HWA, Inc.

Michael Sites

After the passing of our family Airedale (my daughters Misty), I began searching the internet, I found the HWA. Networking brought me to Lawrence Alexander, Dale Burrier and Ed Weiss. They were very helpful.

We attended our first Nationals in 2010, 4-weeks after Misty passed, to be around Airedales...and hopefully find a breeder. I wanted a hunting dog. I knew nothing about hunting Airedales and less about hunt training. We were incredibly fortunate to obtain the last pup of Dale's litter at the Nationals; the best one.

In 2011, I entered Kira in the Hunting Instinct test. Kira had the highest score, 94%. Stew Tardiff told me that if I did not come back to the next Nationals having trained Kira he would kick my b***. With advice from Ed, Dale and Lawrence, books, Youtube and 5-months working with a local trainer we came back in 2012 and Kira passed both Junior Upland and Retrieving tests. Meanwhile, we hunted quail, chukar and pheasant in South Dakota, Missouri and Illinois.

The 11-months prior to the 2013 Nationals, Kira passed eight straight AKC events and received her JH and SH AKC titles. At the 2013 Nationals, Kira passed both the Senior Upland and Retriever tests. I also had the great pleasure of assisting Stew Tardiff with the Hunting Instinct test.

We continued hunting quail, chukar and pheasant in South Dakota, Missouri and Illinois and this spring Kira passed her AKC Senior Fur test to achieve her SHV title.

I am currently serving as the HWA Treasurer, active on the Events Committee and will be helping to judge the Hunting Instinct test at the 2014 Nationals.

Since 1995 perpetual awards have been given to encourage Airedales to train and participate in the Airedale Hunt Test Program.
